Ability to Give Space for Others

You can bring energy and vibrancy to the room (or Zoom room) while making space for others. You challenge yourself and others to participate while also being compassionate towards everyone's personal situation.

Listening Skills

You know how to listen well, giving full attention to whomever is speaking. You show your care through active listening and active reflection.

Timeliness

You can show up to all OSWx meetings on Tuesdays and Thursdays consistently for 6 months. Should any obstacle come in between attendance to a meeting, you would let someone know prior to this and find another Peer Leader or OSWx member to fill in for you. You are able to maintain and track logistics of the calendar.

Vulnerability

You know how to share openly and honestly with others. You always bring your authentic self to the table. You understand that vulnerability fosters connections.

You're the party-thrower, not the party-goer

You bring energy and excitement to the group. While the group is a space for you to show up as you are, your main priority is to allow others to be present with their own experience.
